<b>Description:</b>	If you add a server to Smuxi that only uses digits for the username or password, then Smuxi will crash. This is a bug in the config backend. The only workaround is currently to change the value so it contains at least one non-digit. The value can be changed by opening the smuxi-engine.ini file using a text editor.
