

## Smuxi - Bug # 308: Netsplit triggers "excess flood" kick cycle on Freenode

<b>Subject:</b>	Netsplit triggers "excess flood" kick cycle on Freenode		
<b>Description:</b>	<p>This might be because I've got 15 channels open on Freenode, but netsplits on Freenode are triggering a cycle of kick &amp; rejoin on Freenode for me. Something in the netsplit causes Smuxi to trigger an excess-flood kick from Freenode, and then when Smuxi reconnects it again triggers an excess-flood kick. The cycle continues, sometimes for half an hour.</p> <p>I attach a debug log of one such flood/reconnect/flood/... cycle. Warning! It's 20MB uncompressed.</p>
