It gets triggered for new installs and existing installs without remote engines.

Added check to only use default(T) for value types, fixing the startup crash. (closes: #405)

The config backend returned null values for empty strings when using the Get<T>() method which GetList() does. That happened because value types like bool and int need extra handling in case the value is empty using the default(T) construct. This extra handling was also applied for regular string values and default(string) returned null.
