Description:	<p>Smuxi 0.8.10 breaks long lines and aligns them with the end of the nick that wrote the line.</p> <p>This is irritating and wastes lot of space, especially when nicks differ in length quite a bit.</p> <p>Also it wastes screen-estate and causes the lines to break even more often.</p> <p>Please align broken lines to the same start, the end of the timestamp for example.</p> <p>Currently.</p> <pre><pre> 15:45 <some_really_long_nick> Hi, I'm writing a long line that is split into multiple ones since alignment is wasteful </pre> Should be: <pre> 15:45 <some_really_long_nick> Hi, I'm writing a long line that is split into multiple ones since alignment is wasteful </pre></pre>
