<b>Description:</b>	<p>If you want "normal" users to use your IRC client wouldn't it be handy if there is documentation within the front-end? Pressing F1 will popup the help form and users can search etc. Or if the user presses F1 it will execute a help file. In windows it would be .chm and in linux should be an equivalent too. This way you don't have to code your own form etc.</p> <p>Because you are releasing major versions now, I would suggest starting with the documentation asap as it only gets more features and text. The documentation should point at the frontend but also the server and the IRC commands.</p> <p>It's just a suggestion.</p>
