<b>Description:</b>	<p>When you create a new filter you don't have much feedback. All you see is that a row is selected:</p> <p>!http://i.imgur.com/mrHUtBM.png!</p> <p>And if an empty filter isn't selected it is even invisible, because it has the same colour as the background. It is confusing!</p> <p>Ideas to solve this:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>a) open a dialog, like other application e.g. alacarte</li><li>b) fill the cells with placeholders (like placeholders in a html text-input-field[1]) - you know the grey text that disappears when you click on/in the object</li></ul> <p>[1]: input type="text" placeholder="Search for titles or tags"</p>
