Description:	<p>If there are two nicks in the room, 'alanA' and 'alanB', then tab completion should only complete 'alan'. Further presses of 'tab' could list the different possibilities onscreen, but not fully complete any name.</p> <p>i.e.</p> <p>Press 'a'</p> <p>press tab</p> <p>*smuxi completes 'alan'*</p> <p>press tab again</p> <p>*smuxi prints 'alanA' and 'alanB' to screen so i know what my options are*</p> <p>press 'A' (or a)</p> <p>press tab again</p> <p>*smuxi finishes the name leaving me with 'alanA: '*</p>
