Description:	It would be nice to appear as away to others when you are not connected to the smuxi-server. I never used /away but relied on the bouncer to do that.

When the last connected frontend disconnects from the session and when a frontend connects again it will automatically update the away state for all protocol managers.

This feature introduces a simple presence API which each protocol manager can support. (closes: #454)
