<b>Description:</b>	<p>It would be a nice feature to mirror a notice in the currently opened tab in the frontend, if that belongs to the same server. Should be configurable, though.</p> <p>&lt;Salz&gt; hm, it would be a nice feature though to mirror the notice in the current opened tab &lt;Salz&gt; if it is on the same server &lt;meebey&gt; Salz: please file a ticket for that &lt;meebey&gt; Salz: smuxi knows the current tab of the frontend &lt;meebey&gt; Salz: so it can copy it there &lt;meebey&gt; ahh no &lt;meebey&gt; nvm &lt;Salz&gt; shouldn't the frontend do this? what happens if you have several clients? &lt;meebey&gt; only it was a command from the user &lt;meebey&gt; notices come from the IRCd &lt;meebey&gt; so smuxi needs to duplicate that to all frontend managers &lt;meebey&gt; doable but more nasty &lt;meebey&gt; Salz: no, the client doesnt even know what CTCP is &lt;meebey&gt; it has to be an engine feature &lt;meebey&gt; in that case a protocol manager feature &lt;Salz&gt; meehey: yes but you could send out a "notice \$text on \$server" to the frontends &lt;Salz&gt; however that would translate to rpc calls in mono :)</p>
