<b>Subject:</b>	Channels are not well-ordered on server join		
<b>Description:</b>	<p>When starting the server connection process - either on initial smuxi-engine connection, or when connecting to a new server - the channels are not displayed in the order specified in the IRC server's preferences window.</p> <p>Worse, when starting up the smuxi-engine, the channel tabs and server tabs are not associated at all - the channels from multiple servers are interleaved and the server tabs bear no obvious relation to the channels.</p> <p>This does not appear to be deterministic.</p>
