Description:	<p>The format of the value of the @PREFIX@ server property is @modesprefixes@, e.g.</p> <p>(ov)@+ or (qaohv)~&@&+</p> <p>The current code splits the string at the @)@, but doesn't skip the initial @(@. Therefore, it returns @null@ in all valid cases because the mode string and the prefix string aren't equally long.</p>

Fix PREFIX misparse (closes #854).

Not skipping the leading '(' when splitting on the ')' always makes the modes list longer than the prefix list, which leads to an incorrect null return value.
