Description:	<p>When joining a channel or opening a new tab, it is unnatural that a tab gets opened at position 1. As an example when i have the following channels open: [test1] - [test2] - [test3] - [test4] so when i type: /join #test5 a "normal" user would expect that the tab/channel gets added at the end of the list. No smuxi adds the tab in front of the existing tabs resulting in this: *[test5]* - [test1] - [test2] - [test3] - [test4] I checked if it maybe was sorted alphabetical, but no it wasn't.</p> <p>Just a suggestion == ==</p>
