<b>Description:</b>	<p>Hello, please store the passwords in the system keyring using the cross-platform libsecret.</p> <p>I am not sure if there is a C# library for libsecret, but you could use the @secret-tool@ program as a subprocess to do the work for you.</p> <p>Something like</p> <pre>&lt;pre&gt;secret-tool store --label="Smuxi password" protocol IRC network irc.freenode.net account infinity0 secret-tool lookup protocol IRC network irc.freenode.net account infinity0 &lt;/pre&gt;</pre>
